| 3. Take exit 156 for I-80/I-90 toward Toll Rd/Chicago/Toledo |  | 0.2 mi |
| 4. Keep left at the fork to continue toward I-80 W/I-90 W
Partial toll road |  | 0.2 mi |
| 5. Keep left at the fork, follow signs for I-80 W/I-90 W/Chicago and merge onto I-80 W/I-90 W |  | 113 mi |
| 6. Take exit 31 toward IN-49/Chesterton/Valparaiso |  | 0.3 mi |
| 7. Continue straight onto Gateway Blvd
Partial toll road |  | 0.2 mi |
| 8. Turn left at N Calumet Ave |  | 1.2 mi |
| 9. Turn left at E 1100 N |  | 1.1 mi |
| 10. Take the 3rd left onto S 11th St
Destination will be on the left |  | 0.2 mi |
